POSITION OVERVIEW

The Development and Communications internship at Shepherd's Table is an opportunity to dive into social media, fundraising, and donor engagement at a mission-driven, community organization. Our interns are passionate about food and housing security for everyone in our community and are ready to leverage communication and fundraising to this end. The internship will specifically center on social media but will entail broad engagement with different components of nonprofit development, including event planning, storytelling, donor relations, data entry, and more.

This is an in-office for Fall 2022 based in downtown Silver Spring, MD.

Specific roles and responsibilities:

- Assisting with the planning and strategy of social media across Facebook, Twitter, Instagram, and LinkedIn
- Writing social media copy
- Researching social media strategy and cutting-edge practices
- Creating on-brand graphics for social media posts
- Responding to messages and comments from our audience across platforms
- Writing and sending donor acknowledgements
- Data entry and maintenance within Salesforce
- Creating internal newsletters
- Assisting with event planning for fundraisers and donor gatherings
