



Local Advocacy Priorities



HOUSING & HOMELESSNESS

- Increase deeply affordable housing supply in the county
- Increase funding for Permanent Supportive Housing (PSH)
- Work to maintain chronic homelessness at functional zero



HUNGER & FOOD INSECURITY

- Increase funding to local food assistance providers due to rising food costs
- Dedicate effort to increasing SNAP utilization rate
- See Office of Food Systems Resilience establish and implement a strategic plan that includes people and families experiencing homelessness



BEHAVIORAL HEALTH

- Fund and revamp Mobile Crisis Response Unit, including opening four crisis beds
- Break ground on Restoration Center
- Hold local behavioral health providers accountable for providing adequate care to PSH residents
