



HOUSING & HOMELESSNESS

- Increase deeply affordable housing and Permanent Supportive Housing supply in the county
- Ensure safety and stability for currently unhoused residents
- Enact and fund eviction prevention policies



HUNGER & FOOD INSECURITY

- Increase funding to local food assistance providers due to rising food costs
- Dedicate effort to increasing SNAP utilization rate
- See the Office of Food Sytems Resilience established and implement a strategic plan that includes people and families experiencing homelessness



BEHAVIORAL HEALTH

- Achieve 24/7 mental health crisis services throughout the entire county
- Support the opening of beds at the crisis center and opening of the restoration center
- Invest in behavioral health workforce
